

Spring Carving Class

The Herschell Carrousel Factory Museum is proud to offer two levels of carving classes this Spring. Space is limited, reserve your spot today!

Four Saturdays: March 8th, 15th, & 22nd and 29th

Beginner Woodcarving Classes 9:00 AM – 12:00PM **\$110 (\$100 for Carousel Society Members)**

Aimed at students who have no carving experience or are self-taught carvers who lack specialized technical training, this series of classes introduces tool safety, sharpening, material selection, and finishing. Participants will work on a different project each week, including carving in the round and relief carving. Fee includes instruction, a tool kit to keep, and materials for projects; students bring a pencil to class.

Intermediate/Advanced Woodcarving Class 1:00PM – 4:00PM **\$95 (\$90 for Carousel Society Members)**

Admission to this class is with instructor approval or completion of the beginner course. Our project is a carving an American bison in the round. A pattern and wood will be supplied. The students must bring their own tools including: a ruler, a pencil, two 6 inch c-clamps, a carving arm, and a non-slip pad. –OR– Students may supply their own pattern and wood and receive guidance on their project. Tools must be supplied by the student.

*All classes are taught by Doug Bathke, a Trustee at the museum, who has been carving for 62 years and teaching for 55+. **Registration and pre-payment are required by Wednesday March 5th; call 716-693-1885 to register.** Classes are a series and cannot be taken individually. Fees are non-refundable after the first class. Maximum enrollment is 12 students for the Beginner and Intermediate/Advanced classes. All classes are ages 18 and up.*
